## RSNA Introduction to Research for International Young Academics

Since 2000, the **Radiological Society of North America (RSNA)** has supported international radiologic education through the **RSNA Introduction to Research for International Young Academics Program**.

The focus of this program is to encourage young radiologists from countries outside the United States and Canada to pursue careers in academic radiology. The program consists of a special seminar that is held during the RSNA Scientific Assembly and Annual Meeting.

Eligible candidates are residents and fellows currently in radiology training programs, or radiologists not more than two years out of training, who are beginning or considering an academic career. **Nominations must be made by the candidate's department chairperson or training director.** Fluency in English is required.

*The purpose of this program is to:*

- Introduce residents to research early in their training;
- Demonstrate the importance of research to the practice and future of radiology;
- Share the excitement and satisfactions of research careers in radiology, and
- Introduce residents to successful clinical radiology researchers, future colleagues and potential mentors
